The Grayson County Detention Center is implementing a phased re-opening of our facilities to the public beginning on Monday, July 13, 2020.

While we are still strongly recommending utilization of the video conferencing opportunities offered by the Detention Center, in-person visitation for attorneys will resume on July 13. All attorneys who wish to participate in an in-person visit must submit an email video@gcdetention.com at least 24 hours prior to your requested meeting time. Only one in-person attorney visit will be scheduled at any one time with a period built in between visits for sanitizing the visiting area. All attorneys are required to submit to a COVID-19 screening prior to their visit so those participating will have to arrive on site at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled meeting time. Attorneys and their participating clients are required to wearing protective face masks and adhere to social distancing guidelines for the duration of the visit. Failure to do so will result in the visit being immediately ended and further restrictions on future in-person visits.

Inmate visitation through the glass will resume its normal schedule on Wednesday, July 15, 2020 with additional restrictions in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Visits will be on an appointment-only basis with scheduling required at least 24 hours in advance. Only one visitor will be allowed per inmate with no exceptions. A cap has been placed on the number of visitors allowed inside the facility at any one time. Each building's total number of on-site visitors is broken down below:

Main facility: 8 visitors per session
Female Facility: 2 visitors per session
Annex: 1 visitor per session

Visits will continue to be 15 minutes in length with periods built in between every session for cleaning and sanitizing purposes. Visitors will be required to wear a protective face mask the entire time they are in a Detention Center facility, including the visit. Failure to abide by these restrictions will result in the immediate termination of the visit and sanctions on future visits. No switching visit stations will be allowed during visits – you will be required to remain in your assigned visitation booth for the entire visit. Lobby restrooms remain closed at this time and will not be opened for visitation. To give all inmates equal access, scheduled visitation times will be strictly adhered to. Visitors will not be let into any detention center building until five minutes prior to the scheduled time for the visit to begin. Visitors may also be required to undergo a COVID-19 screening prior to entry. Refusal to do so will result in the visit being cancelled.
