Yearly Breakdown of PREA Investigations

2021

Overview

The Grayson County Detention Center investigated 4 PREA-reportable incidents in the calendar year of 2021. This is down from 11 reported incidents in 2020.

Two allegations were determined to be unfounded following investigative procedures.

One allegation was made from a third-party avenue, (phone call from parent), determined to be unfounded after the alleged victim admitted relaying false information to the third party.

One other allegation was referred to another agency for investigation, when the alleged victim claimed sexual assault while incarcerated at that agency.

Agency Efforts


The Grayson County Detention Center continues to make every effort to educate staff, volunteers and inmates on PREA issues. Our reporting methods remain unchanged from previous years and all inmates are provided upon intake with PREA reporting information.

Recommendations

The agency should maintain and possibly increase inmate education efforts in line with the agency's goals with regard to PREA. Staff training should continue to exceed recommended levels to further enhance the agency's ability to combat sexual abuse and harassment
